

ABSTRACT

The master's dissertation is devoted to the systematic study of the theoretical and practical aspects of the implementation of e-government in Ukraine, which was formed through the prism of the experience of the functioning of e-governance in Japan. The approaches of foreign and native scientists to the definition of the concept of e-government and e-democracy are highlighted, the main tools of e-democracy have been determined, their review has been conducted. The peculiarities of e-governance implementation at the national, regional and local levels in Japan have been considered in detail. It also describes state policy on e-government development and explores Japan's major government portals and e-services.

Taking into account the comparison made with the relevant practice in Japan, directions for improving the functioning of e-governance in Ukraine are proposed. Recommendations on implementation of effective e-governance and improvement of its functioning have been developed.
