Department of The Theory and Practice of Management of Igor Sikorsky Kyiv Polytechnic Institute has offered for review the educational and professional program for the training of specialists in the field of public administration. Our educational and research team was exceptionally interested in the proposal, as our school also trains specialists in Public Management and Administration, so we were keen to learn about relevant practices in Ukraine.

For countries undergoing large-scale transformations at all levels of society (including both Ukraine and Georgia), the training of highly qualified public managers capable of initiating, designing and monitoring changes in the management system is particularly relevant. It is difficult to overestimate the extent of the impact of human resources in public service on the effectiveness of reforms in the country. Therefore, the responsibility of educational institutions that participate in its formation is unique, because indirectly they can influence the course of positive changes in society.

On the basis of this considerations we decided to review the proposed educational program. As a result, we want to note its logical sequence and balance. The content of the program is not only relevant and consistent with existing practices in the development of educational programs in different countries, but also has a strategic vector and is future-oriented. The program focuses on building the set of competencies needed to make

responsible, informed decisions in the context of sustainable development of society, community, and public administration, in particular. This is evidenced by the inclusion in the list of required disciplines the component "Management tools for sustainable development", a significant number of credits are given to the discipline "Public Policy and Governance", students are given opportunities for internships and other training related to such competencies .

Thus, the educational-professional program "Public Administration and e-Government" for the second (master's) level within the specialty 281 "Public Management and Administration" contains a relevant set of normative disciplines and offers a wide range of selective ones, which provides an opportunity to conduct quality training of specialists who meet the level of higher education master's degree and are able to successfully pursue further employment and career development in public sector organizations.
